Just one more sleep until Queensland's biggest and most anticipated Show, the EKKA, opens and the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland (RNA) is encouraging Queenslanders to come along and see what's FRESH in 2006.

The Royal Queensland Show or "EKKA" kicks off on Thursday 10 August, running to Saturday 19 August at the RNA Showgrounds in Brisbane.

Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland (RNA) President Dr Vivian Edwards OAM said there was ten days of non-stop fun planned for the 130^{th} EKKA.

"The EKKA has been held continuously at its present day site in Bowen Hills since 1876, with only two exceptions – 1919 when Brisbane suffered a Spanish influenza epidemic and in wartime in 1942 when the Showgrounds were used as a staging depot for troops moving north," Dr Edwards said.

"What sets our Show apart from others around the country is its unique location in the heart of this wonderful city and the undeniable support from people across the State.

"The EKKA provides many city people with their first and only opportunity to experience life in the country and see some of the best products and produce that Queensland has to offer.

"This year's EKKA will be as 'Fresh as you like!' with fabulous fresh entertainment, live music, showbags, food, pavilions, rides and much more," Dr Edwards said.

"Approximately 500,000 people are expected through the gates to learn, discover, be entertained, try, taste, buy, marvel and delight in the many wonderful things that make the EKKA the special event that it is."

Events and Entertainment

It's Showtime, so get ready for the extraordinary range of events and entertainment on offer. Rock returns to the EKKA this year with the Nova Live & Loud @EKKA Concert Series: Little Birdy (Friday 11 August); Evermore (Saturday 12 August) and Shihad (Saturday 19 August). For Moove Alley daredevils there are four new rides. The Australian cabaret circus, Bulldust and Spangles, will have the grown-ups wishing they too could run away and join the circus. Visitors of all ages can challenge themselves by climbing the Base Zero mobile climbing wall in Nova Park.

In 2006 there will be almost 30,000 entries in 40 competitions showcasing Queensland and Australia's best.
