Our competitions are the backbone of the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka), bringing the city and country together each year to showcase the best of the best.

In 2023 the 144th Ekka was the most attended Show since 2019, since before the Covid-19 pandemic. Queensland's biggest and most loved event was an incredible success, attracting around 400,000 people.

We were delighted to once again reward and recognise our exhibitors across 54 competition sections. The RNA received over 20,000 competition entries, a 12% increase on 2022, which is also back to pre-pandemic levels.

More than 4,400 exhibitors travelled from across the country for their chance to win a coveted blue ribbon when the Ekka awards and celebrates the best of the best.

The entries included 4,257 prized animals, 1,231 cakes and condiments and 634 works by Queensland students.

Our competitors were able to share in a total prize pool of almost \$680,000 – a 10% increase on last year.

In 2023 we hosted 10 international judges, ensuring exhibits were judged by some of the world's most highly experienced and respected individuals.

In 2024, the nine-day Show will be held from Saturday 10 August to Sunday 18 August, running over two full weekends.

Since 1875, the RNA has been dedicated to championing agriculture and is honoured to stage Queensland's largest event on behalf of the community each year.

We look forward to continuing this wonderful legacy for future generations of exhibitors and patrons to enjoy.

- 1. Entry fee of \$2.50 per entry, per class applies.
- Entries must be received and payment in full online at www.ekka.com.au no later than 5.00pm on 2 August 2024.
- 3. After entries have closed exhibitors will receive an E-Label issued by the RNA via email, which must be affixed to each entry prior to delivery. Please affix to packaging and carton also.
- Cheeses are to have the following details labelled on each entry:
 - Best Before Date (8 weeks after cheese is made)
 - Date of Production
 - School Name
 - Student Name
 - Name of Cheese e.g. "Jane's Camembert"
- Only cheeses made under DFSV Food Safety Plan can be entered.
- 6. All Food and Safety documents required for auditing must be completed, posted and received by the RNA prior to the judging date. Post all audit documents to the following address:

- 7. Exhibits will be delivered and collected from the judging premises at the exhibitors own expense.
- 8. Entries in the Student Made Cheese Class can be from Primary, Secondary or Tertiary Students.
- Schools are restricted to twelve (12) entries per competition class.
- 10. No late entries will be accepted.
- 11. The Association reserves the right to declare no competition in any class in which there are less than three entries.
- 12. Prizes will be awarded on a first, second and third basis only.

PRIZE MONEY

- 3. The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.
